Pastor Mike is on sabbatical during June and July. Please join us in praying for him and Mary as they take this time to rest and renew so they can come back ready for all that God has for us here at Trinity in the coming year.

In the meantime, the Trinity staff has planned some creative opportunities for worship, fellowship, and Bible study this summer! A different ministerial staff person will be preaching each Sunday but the focus in worship in June and July will be on characters in the Bible – and there are some characters! Some of these individuals you will recognize, others may be new to you but either way, there is much to learn from their stories.

We start with Glenn preaching about Eutychus on June 7. The following Sunday, Teresa will be preaching on Hebrews 11 about the great stories of the faith and the role of story in our faith. On June 21, which is Father's Day, Glenn will move to a character in the Old Testament as he preaches about Balaam. We end the month back in the New Testament as Lane preaches about Zaccheus on June 28.

As in previous summers, our InterGen Nites will be on Wednesdays at 6pm in June, except for June 17 which is the week of VBS. Our theme this summer is "Breaking Bread" and we will gather around tables in the fellowship hall as we learn about stories of breaking bread in the Bible. On June 3 we will learn about the Passover meal, June 10 is about Jesus feeding the people, and we end on June 24 with Jesus' parable about the Great Banquet. There will be activities, Bible reading, and prayer that will be accessible to kids and adults alike! There will also be a snack that we will share as we break bread together. And there is childcare for our little ones who are 3 years and under.

Worship in July will continue with our focus on Biblical characters but our Wednesday nights will shift to opportunities for intergenerational fellowship! We will take a break on Wednesday, July 1, but the following three Wednesday nights may be outside or inside depending on the weather.

Pastor Mike and Mary are on sabbatical this summer, but we hope that you are not and that you stay connected and growing in your relationship with God and others during this special summer with us!

Trinity’s investment in a handbell ministry is one that helps to bring glory to God as musicians develop and refine their God-given musical talents and interests for use in the worship of God. Ringing handbells is an engaging experience that helps to develop a sense of rhythm and overall musicianship. Trinity’s music library includes a great deal of excellent musical selections arranged for handbell choirs—hymn settings, beautiful newly composed music, and a variety of styles and difficulty levels. All of this has helped Trinity ringers to deepen and broaden in their expressions of musical praise and witness.

Also, and importantly, a handbell choir is an amazing opportunity for fellowship. The Trinity Carillon is very much like a family, interested in the needs of fellow ringers, offering care and support at times of need, and creatively helping to strengthen the fabric of our church.

This past year of ministry has seen the Trinity Carillon bring beautiful music for worship each month (August through May), and the “Morning Ring in June” caps off the year with a reprise of four or five of the ten selections in their 2025-26 folders.

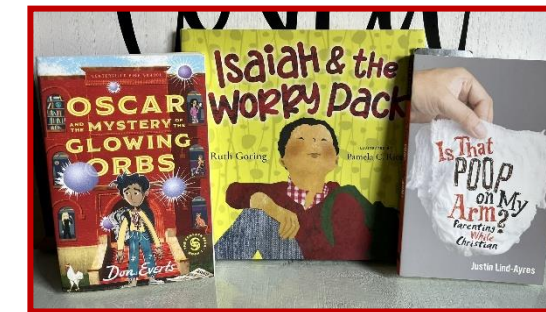
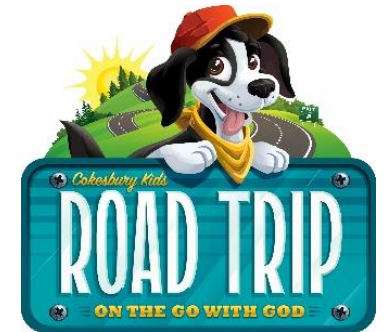
Vacation Bible School
