Earlier this month in a dramatic sketch we learned much about Frances Ridley Havergal, who composed our Hymn of the Month for June, "Take My Life, and Let It Be Consecrated." Her life was an example of living in the Spirit of Christ as she sought to follow Jesus in every area of her existence. Her hymns have stood the test of time and earned her the nickname of "the Consecration Poet."

What does "Consecrate" mean? "To make or declare sacred; especially to devote irrevocably to the worship of God."

As we sing (and pray) her hymn this month, we are asking God to take all that we have (our hands, feet, and voice; our silver and our gold; our moments and our days; even our heart and our will) and to consecrate and use it all in the service of Christ.

Please note that the Sanctuary Choir WILL NOT meet for rehearsal this Wednesday, July 1st. The morning anthem scheduled for July 5 is *In Christ Alone*.
