His anthem today is based entirely upon the scripture lesson found in Micah 6:6-8. The contemplative text calls for self-examination and commitment. The act of worship at its core is centered upon responding to God's grace with offerings of life, resources, and service. The fact that our worship service today includes the ordinance of communion is even more of a reason for utilizing an expression of response and action.
