Our Hymn of the Month for August is "My Faith Has Found a Resting Place." It was our organ prelude last week and today's expression is shared by a vocal quartet from the Sanctuary Choir (Jennie Prinkey, Jane Orton, Dan Walther, and Frank McCall). While the exact origin of its text and tune are not certain in hymnological scholarship, the basic message of the hymn is clear--the only truly essential statement for Christ-followers is that *"it is enough that Jesus died, and that He died for me."*

The choir's anthem and the vocal solo each contain worship-filled responses to the message of salvation through God's grace alone--we give Christ our praise and our commitment of life and resources.
